## **Firearms Restriction**

### For convictions of any of the following charges, a firearm restriction will apply.

#### Any Felony

• Lifetime prohibition

#### The following Misdemeanors charges carry a lifetime prohibition:

- PC 245(a)(2)
- o PC 246
- PC 417(a)(2) \*Two or more convictions
- o PC 417(c)
- o "Misdemeanor crime of domestic violence"

# **Instructions for Legal Transport of Firearm(s)**

- 1. <u>You must call the law enforcement agency first</u> and notify them that you are turning in a firearm and ammunition per Court order.
- 2. The firearm(s) must not be loaded.
- When transporting the firearm(s) in a vehicle, it must be locked inside the trunk or in a locked container in the back of the vehicle out of arm's reach. (PC 25610).
- 4. The law enforcement agency will give you instructions on surrendering ammunition. Some agencies may ask you to make more than one trip: one trip to surrender the firearm(s) and another trip to surrender the ammunition. Ammunition must be transported in a box or specific ammunition can separate from the firearm(s).
- 5. You must drive straight to the law enforcement agency. Do not stop anywhere else.
- Call the agency immediately when you arrive or go inside and ask for further instructions. <u>Leave the firearm(s) inside the vehicle</u> unless you have been instructed otherwise.
