## **Sacramento Superior Court Judge Swears in New Student Council**

Sacramento, CA – Judge Peter Williams on Tuesday administered the oath of office to new student council officers at Parkway Elementary School.

The school, located in the Parkway Estates neighborhood of South Sacramento, has nearly 500 students. The swearing-in ceremony took place during an all-school assembly attended by 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders while the primary grades participated via Zoom.

Judge Williams administered the oath to two student council secretaries, the vice president, president and grade level representatives.

Student council coordinator and 5th grade teacher Angelia Brie Jones organized the assembly. Her brother, now a probation officer in another state, attended McClatchy High School with Judge Williams.

Also present at the swearing-in ceremony were principal Dr. Krystle Andrews and Sacramento City Unified School District school board president Chinua Rhodes. The students gave speeches in front of their peers on Nov. 6 and were elected to office on Election Day, Nov. 7 using voting booths provided by the Sacramento County Elections Office.
