**STANDING ORDER OF THE
SACRAMENTO SUPERIOR COURT**

**ORDER: SUBORDINATE JUDICIAL
OFFICERS AS TEMPORARY JUDGES**

Under Rule of Court 6.609 (b), I have determined that, because of a shortage of judges, it is necessary for the effective administration of justice that Subordinate Judicial Officers at Carol Miller Justice Center sit as temporary judges on certain unlawful detainer cases converted to limited civil cases pursuant to Civil Code Section 1952.3

Accordingly, all Subordinate Judicial Officers assigned to hear matters at the Carol Miller Justice Center are hereby assigned to sit as temporary judges to hear trials, absent objection from the litigants, on unlawful detainer cases which have been converted to limited civil cases pursuant to Civil Code Section 1952.3 where the complaint has not been amended to include issues other than rent, daily damages, attorney's fees and costs.
