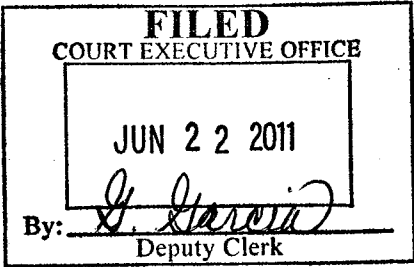

**STANDING ORDER OF THE
SACRAMENTO SUPERIOR COURT**

**ORDER: DESTRUCTION OF
STENOGRAPHIC NOTES**

IT IS HEREBY THE ORDER OF THIS COURT:

Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code section 69955(e), and the policy of the Court, the destruction of stenographic notes should be carried out as follows:

- 1. **Death Penalty/Capital Felony Cases:** upon death of the defendant, or until such time as the Supreme Court on request by the court clerk authorizes the destruction;
- 2. **Criminal Proceedings:** after 10 years from the taking of the notes; and
- 3. **All Other Proceedings:** after five years from the taking of the notes.

This order shall remain in full force and effect until further notice (or until rescinded, revoked, or superseded.)
