**STANDING ORDER OF THE  
SACRAMENTO SUPERIOR COURT**

**FIRST AMENDED ORDER:  
WAIVING TEMPORARY JUDGE  
LIMITATION FOR JUVENILE  
DEPENDENCY CASES PURSUANT TO  
CRC RULE 2.818(b)(1)**

WHEREAS, the Court finds there is a continuing shortage of judicial assets in Sacramento County, and

WHEREAS, volunteer attorneys are needed to serve as court-appointed temporary judges in Family Law cases at the William R. Ridgeway Family Relations Courthouse, and

WHEREAS, volunteer attorneys, by limitations established by subdivision (b) of Rule 2.818, are disqualified from serving as a temporary judge on a day in which the volunteer attorney is required to appear in a Juvenile Court dependency case in the same courthouse as an attorney, and


WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge finds good cause and is authorized to waive the limitations established in subdivision (b) of Rule 2.818;

**IT IS THE ORDER OF THIS COURT** that the limitation established in Rule 2.818(b)(1) is waived for a volunteer attorney serving as a Family Law temporary judge on a day in which he or she is

1 required to appear as an attorney in a Juvenile Court dependency case in the same courthouse.
