**ORDER REQUIRING CIVIL LITIGANTS
TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL COPY OF
ALL CASE INITIATING PLEADINGS AT
TIME OF FILING**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Effective November 21, 2011, all civil litigants filing case initiating pleadings, including complaints, cross-complaints, petitions and applications, shall provide to a filing clerk at the front counter one additional complete paper copy of the pleading at the time of filing.

The additional copy of the pleading shall be placed by the filing clerk in a receptacle labeled Public Access Bin on the day of filing and made available for public inspection subject to the restrictions of California Rules of Court, Title 2, Division 4. No person shall remove any pleading in the Public Access Bin from the court building. Any person inspecting a pleading from the Public Access Bin may copy it inside the courthouse at that person's own expense. The person shall promptly return the pleading to the Public Access Bin after inspection/copying.
