Consistent with Local Rule 1.06, a tentative ruling will be published on the Court's website under Departments 53 or 54 at 2:00 p.m. on the court day before the matter is scheduled to be heard. [Tentative Ruling Search By Department \(ca.gov\)](#).

To request oral argument on a matter, parties must call the Law and Motion Oral Argument Request line at (916) 874-2615 by 4:00 p.m. the court day before the hearing and leave a voice mail message with all of the information specified in the voice mail greeting. Parties are further required to notify all opposing parties of the oral argument request.

Unless ordered to appear in person by the Court, parties may appear remotely, either telephonically or by video conference via the Zoom video/audio conference platform with notice to the Court and all other parties in accordance with Code of Civil Procedure 367.75. Although remote participation is not required, the Court will presume all parties are appearing remotely for non-evidentiary civil hearings.
