Public Notice – Civil Division Wednesday Coverage of Law and Motion Calendar

All moving papers, replies, and opposition must be filed (1) via eFiling following the guidelines at <u>https://www.saccourt.ca.gov/civil/e-filing.aspx</u>, (2) in person at the Hall of Justice Building, 813 6th Street, Room 212, 2nd Floor Sacramento, CA 95814, or (3) sent by mail to 720 9th Street, Room 102, Sacramento, CA 95814.

Consistent with Local Rule 1.06, a tentative ruling will be published in the case at 2:00 p.m. on the court day before the matter is scheduled to be heard. Log in to the <u>public</u> <u>portal</u> to access the case.

To request oral argument on a matter, parties must call the Law and Motion Oral Argument Request line at (916) 874-2615 by 4:00 p.m. the court day before the hearing and leave a voice mail message with all of the information specified in the voice mail greeting. Parties are further required to notify all opposing parties of the oral argument request.

Unless ordered to appear in person by the Court, parties may appear remotely, either telephonically or by video conference via the Zoom video/audio conference platform with notice to the Court and all other parties in accordance with Code of Civil Procedure 367.75. Although remote participation is not required, the Court will presume all parties are appearing remotely for non-evidentiary civil hearings.

The Zoom link and Meeting ID needed to appear remotely may be found in the tentative ruling published to the Court's website at 2:00 p.m. on the court day before the matter is scheduled to be heard.
