COURT ORDER FOR MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION
Welfare and Institutions Code §§ 727, 739(c)

The Juvenile Court, having determined that there is no parent/guardian capable of authorizing or willing to authorize remedial care for the above-named Minor, does hereby order that the Sacramento County Probation Department may authorize medical, surgical, dental, psychological, psychiatric and other remedial care and treatment for the Minor by licensed practitioners (not to include administration of psychotropic medications), as may from time to time appear necessary, and does further authorize the duly appointed staff of placement facilities/institutions, foster parents or relative caretakers with whom the Minor lives to authorize such care. Such remedial care includes, but is not limited to, X-ray examination, anesthetic, medical and surgical diagnosis and treatment, psychological and psychiatric diagnosis and counseling, and hospital care to be rendered to the Minor upon advice of, and under the general or special supervision of, a licensed physician and surgeon, a licensed psychologist and psychiatrist, or a licensed dentist.

COURT ORDER FOR NOTICE TO PARENTS

The Juvenile Court also orders that in any event where such medical, surgical, psychological, psychiatric, dental or other remedial care is provided, the Sacramento County Probation Department shall, as soon as reasonably possible, inform the Minor’s parent/guardian what care or treatment was provided and what, if any, further care is scheduled for the Minor.

COURT ORDER FOR RELEASE OF MEDICAL INFORMATION
Welfare and Institutions Code § 739(e)

The Juvenile Court also orders that in any event where such medical, surgical, psychological, psychiatric, dental or other remedial care is provided, the practitioner is authorized to release information and records concerning that care of the Minor to the Sacramento County Probation Department.

This order shall be effective until revoked in writing.
