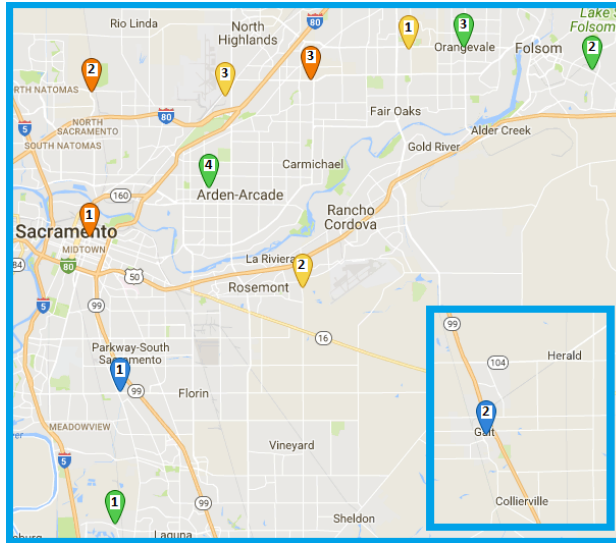

DUI Programs: The Law

An individual's driving privilege will be suspended when charged with a DUI. According to the DMV, the suspension or revocation is an immediate administrative action taken against the driving privilege only. This is called Administrative Per Se (APS). Any sanctions imposed by DMV under APS are independent of any court-imposed jail sentence, fine, or other criminal penalty imposed when an individual is convicted for driving under the influence.

An individual with a DUI will be required to complete a State of California Licensed DUI Program before eligible to obtain an unrestricted license. However, the individual may be qualified to drive after a minimum 30-day suspension with a restricted license (depending on the charges and the County). Enrollment in a licensed DUI program is required to qualify.

As of July 2017, Sacramento County's State-licensed DUI Programs are Breining Institute, Bridges Professional Treatment Services, Safety Center, Inc. and Terra Nova Counseling Center.

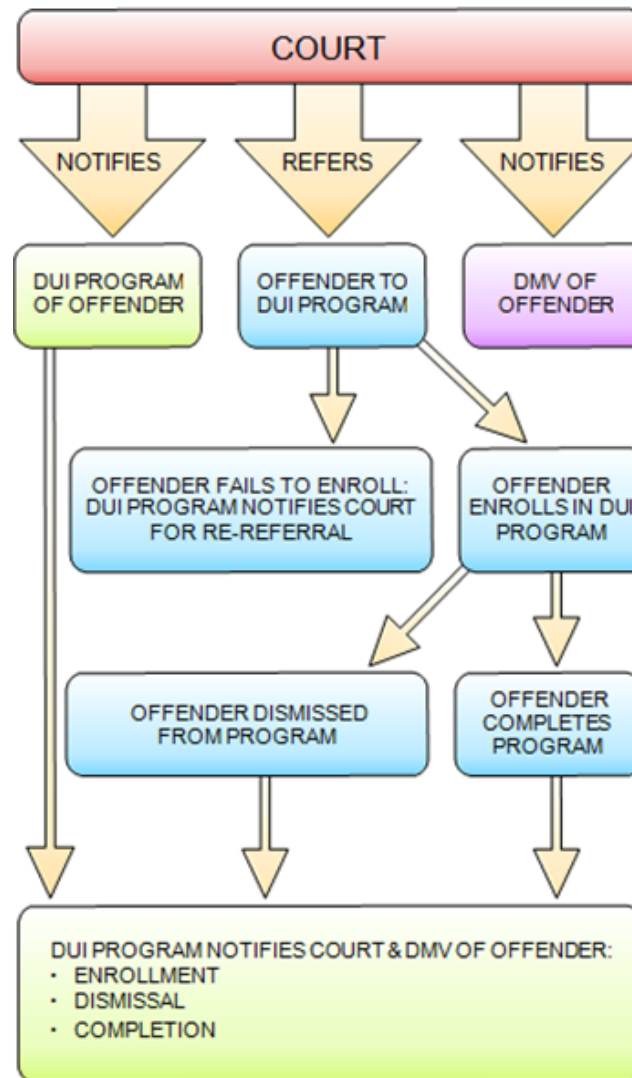

DUI Offender Process



Following an arrest for a DUI, offenders present themselves in Court. Upon Court conviction, the DMV and the DUI Program are notified of the offender, and the offender is referred to a DUI Program; failure to do so will result in a notification to the Court for a re-referral. The DUI Program notifies the Court of an offender's enrollment in, completion of, or dismissal from the program.

DUI Programs & Fees

Sacramento County DUI Program fees are established by the County and are the same for all programs.

1st Offender Programs

Wet & Reckless

12-hour program
Minimum 6 weeks duration Educational groups
Program fee: \$300

3-Month Program

Below 0.15% BAC
30-hour program
Minimum 3 months duration
Includes face-to-face sessions, educational and process groups
MADD Victim Impact Panel Program fee: \$675

6-Month Program

0.15% - 0.19% BAC
45-hour program
Minimum 6 months duration
Includes face-to-face sessions, educational and process groups
MADD Victim Impact Panel Program fee: \$860

9-Month Program

0.20% or higher BAC
60-hour program
Minimum 9 months duration
Includes face-to-face sessions, educational and process groups
MADD Victim Impact Panel Program fee: \$1,140

Multiple Offender Program

18-Month Program

More than one conviction in ten years
76.5-hour program
Minimum 18 months duration
Includes face-to-face sessions, educational and process groups
6-hour community re-entry phase in last 6 months
MADD Victim Impact Panel
Program fee: \$1,700
