

ORDER

Closure of Downtown Courthouses – June 1, 2020

Due to the civil unrest experienced in the City of Sacramento on May 31, 2020, and consistent with the California Department of Human Resources resulting directive to close other state buildings today for public business, the Presiding Judge orders the closure of the following courthouses to protect the safety of the public, court employees and judicial officers: Gordon D. Schaber Sacramento County Courthouse, the Hall of Justice Courthouse, and the Lorenzo Patiño Hall of Justice at the Sacramento County Main Jail.


