SUBJECT: Jury Trials and Jury Service – Temporary Suspension Extended

Sacramento, CA– In response to the continuing “stay at home” order by Governor Newsom, the Sacramento Region falling within the parameters of that order on December 8, 2020 and the current surge in COVID-19 activity in the region, the Sacramento Superior Court will extend the temporary suspension of its jury trials and jury service until January 29, 2021. The court is deemed an “essential service” and will in all other areas of court operations remain open to the public and serve the public through remote means. The court is committed to reducing the number of people in our facilities to protect the public, judicial officers and employees.

Again, the pause in jury trials and jury service is temporary and in direct response to the current health environment.
