NOTICE OF OMICRON MITIGATION PLAN

California continues to experience positive COVID-19 cases due to the omicron variant. With that, we will continue to follow the temporary mitigation measures effectuated on January 5 through **February 14th**:

- Restrict the number of jury trials assigned;
- Continue with physical distancing requirements;
- Utilize vacant departments for jury deliberations to ensure appropriate physical distancing;
- Restrict the number of preliminary hearings/other evidentiary hearings being assigned;
- Encourage parties to appear remotely as much as possible;
- Lighten calendars, where appropriate and possible;
- Ensure all parties are complying with the current mask mandate.

We will continue to monitor the situation and will scale up or scale down depending on the current circumstances.

As always, please stay home if you have any of the following symptoms:

- Fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
- Chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- New loss of taste or smell
