ORDER

IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF

(Cal. Gov. Code §68115)

Pursuant to the authority granted by order of the Chief Justice of the California Supreme Court as Chairperson of the Judicial Council, and upon the grounds specified in California Government Code section 68115,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED,

1. The time period provided in section 825 of the Penal Code within which a defendant charged with a felony offense must be taken before a magistrate is extended from 48 hours to not more than 7 days, applicable only to cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from June 22, 2020, to July 21, 2020, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(8)).

2. The Court may hold sessions anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, from June 22, 2020, to July 21, 2020, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1)).
