**ORDER**  
**IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF**

(Cal. Gov. Code §68115)

Pursuant to the authority granted by order of the Chief Justice of the California Supreme Court as Chairperson of the Judicial Council dated September 15, 2020, and upon the grounds specified in California Government Code section 68115,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED,**

1. This Court may hold sessions anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, from September 22, 2020, to October 22, 2020, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1));

2. The Court extends the time period provided in section 825 of the Penal Code within which a defendant charged with a felony offense must be taken before a magistrate from 48 hours to not more than 7 days, applicable only to cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from September 13, 2020 to October 12, 2020, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(8));

3. The Court extends the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than an additional 30 days, applicable only to cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise would expire from

1 September 21, 2020 through October 21, 2020, inclusive. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10); Executive  
2 Order N-38-20 (03-27-20));
