

ORDER

Access To Juvenile Court Proceedings By General Public-Restricted

1. Out of concern for public health and safety due to the COVID-19 pandemic, effective immediately and until further notice, only those persons with court hearings *in specified juvenile trials* shall enter a Sacramento Juvenile Court facility (Juvenile Courthouse at 9605 Kiefer Boulevard, Sacramento CA 95817 or Family Relations Courthouse at 3441 Power Inn Road, Sacramento CA 95826) on the day of trial. Persons who are permitted to enter for contested evidentiary proceedings shall only be persons authorized by the law to be present at the confidential juvenile hearing and shall include those witnesses who will be testifying. Witnesses shall enter the courthouse only on the day for which the witness is providing testimony. For juvenile public trials that are not live streamed via the Court's public live stream channels or other remote public access is not provided, a limited number of members of the public will be permitted to attend. General visitors and casual observers shall remain outside the courthouse and are encouraged to practice social distancing while remaining outside.

2. All persons entering either Sacramento Juvenile Court facility shall wear a face covering or mask at all times while inside the facility and shall submit to a non-invasive temperature screening process.



3. No person shall be permitted to enter if a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher is detected.

4. No person having any symptoms of illness of any kind shall be permitted into a Sacramento Juvenile Court facility, even if those persons are parties, counsel or witnesses.

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY. THIS ORDER MAY BE AMENDED AS CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRE.
