ORDER

IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF

Statewide Emergency Order Issued March 30, 2020
(Cal. Gov. Code §68115)

Pursuant to the authority granted in the Judicial Council of California Statewide Emergency Order by Hon. Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chief Justice Of California and Chair of the Judicial Council, dated March 30, 2020;

This Court ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The time period provided in section 859b of the Penal Code for the holding of a preliminary examination and the defendant's right to release is extended from 10 court days to 30 court days;
2. The time period provided in section 825 of the Penal Code within which a defendant charged with a felony offense must be taken before a magistrate is extended from 48 hours to not more than seven days;
3. The time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a

1 criminal trial is extended by 60 days from the last date on which the statutory deadline otherwise
2 would have expired;

3 4. The time periods provided in sections 583.310 and 583.320 of the Code of Civil
4 Procedure to bring an action to trial are extended by 60 days from the last date on which the
5 statutory deadline otherwise would have expired;

6 5. These extensions are in addition to any relief previously provided to this Court by
7 an emergency order issued by the Chief Justice under a subdivision of Government Code section
8 68115.

9 6. The 60-day continuance of jury trials authorized in the Chief Justice's order of
10 March 23, 2020, shall be calculated from the date for which the trial was previously set or as
11 extended in paragraphs 3 and 4 above, whichever is longer.

12 7. To the extent the directives and declarations set forth in this Order differ with the
13 Court's prior Orders for Implementation of Emergency Relief, issued March 17, 2020, Temporary
14 Court Closure dated March 19, 2020, and Court Closure Extension issued March 30, 2020, this
15 order controls.

16 **THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.**

17 **THIS ORDER MAY BE AMENDED AS CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRE.**
