

ORDER

**RESUMPTION OF SPECIFIED CIVIL SERVICES AND PROCEEDINGS
ORDER OF EXAMINATION CALENDAR (OX CALENDAR)**

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Presiding Judge’s March 17, 2020 Order re: Implementation of Emergency Relief (March 17th Order), among other things, continued until further notice, all scheduled hearings on the Order of Examination Calendar (OX Calendar). The Presiding Judge has now determined that the OX Calendar shall recommence in-person hearings by reservation only and subject to the procedures set forth in the Public Notice – Order of Examination (OX Calendar) posted on the Court’s website on September 9, 2020 (Public Notice). Parties are directed to the Public Notice at www.saccourt.ca.gov/general/coronavirus.aspx.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. Commencing December 4, 2020, the Court will resume the OX Calendar in Department 11, or as otherwise directed by the Presiding Judge. Due to the nature of the OX Calendar, the Court finds good cause to order that OX matters shall be conducted in-person subject to the procedures as set forth in the Public Notice and the Court’s COVID-19 safety protocols.

1 2. The OX Calendar shall be held one-half day per week, on Fridays, from 9:00 a.m.
2 to 12:00 p.m., in Department 11, or as otherwise directed by the Presiding Judge. Parties must
3 reserve a hearing date in Department 11 in advance of submitting any filings, including any
4 Application and Order for Appearance and Examination. No OX matters shall be set or proceed
5 without prior reservation. The number of OX matters that may be reserved and held per hour and
6 per day/week shall be limited.

7 3. OX Calendar matters that were previously continued by the March 17, 2020 Order
8 will receive a case-specific order indicating the procedure that parties must follow to reset their
9 matter. Parties shall refer to the Public Notice for further instructions regarding resetting OX
10 matters.

11 4. New OX Calendar matters (i.e. not previously continued by the March 17, 2020
12 Order) must be set pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Public Notice. Parties shall refer to
13 the Public Notice for instructions regarding setting new OX matters.

14 5. Compliance with the procedure and protocols set forth and referenced in the Public
15 Notice shall be a prerequisite to proceeding with an OX matter on the reserved date and time.

16 6. In-person debtor examinations shall be conducted in a manner that adheres to the
17 Court's COVID-19 protocols, including use of the courtroom and other areas of the courthouse at
18 the direction of the judge presiding over the OX calendar. Prior to coming to Court, all attending
19 parties shall review and comply with the Court's COVID-19 protocols, including, but not limited
20 to use of face-coverings, and shall be prepared to submit to health screenings. Parties shall refer
21 to the Court's website for more information regarding the Court's COVID-19 protocols.

23 **AMENDED AS CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRE.**
