**ORDER**

**RESUMPTION OF SPECIFIED CIVIL SERVICES AND PROCEEDINGS:  
SHORT CAUSE CIVIL TRIAL CALENDAR**

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Presiding Judge’s March 17, 2020 Order re: Implementation of Emergency Relief (March 17th Order), among other things, continued until further notice, all scheduled hearings on the Presiding Judge’s Short Cause Civil Trial Calendar. The Presiding Judge has now determined that the Short Cause Civil Trial Calendar shall recommence by remotely-conducted hearings only, subject to the procedures set forth in the Public Notice – Short Cause Civil Trial Calendar (Public Notice), posted on the Court’s website on September 22, 2020, at [www.saccourt.ca.gov/general/coronavirus.aspx](http://www.saccourt.ca.gov/general/coronavirus.aspx).

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. Beginning November 5, 2020, the Presiding Judge will resume the Short Cause Civil Trial Calendar in Department 47. Short cause civil trials shall be conducted via remote appearance only, by videoconference through the Court’s Zoom platform in Department 47, or in another department as assigned by the Presiding Judge. Pursuant to the Court’s COVID-19 protocols, no in-person appearances are allowed for short cause civil matters.
