SUBJECT: Criminal Jury Trials and Jury Service – Temporarily Delayed

Sacramento, CA– In response to the “stay at home” order by Governor Newsom and the Sacramento Region falling within the parameters of that order on December 8, 2020, the Sacramento Superior Court will extend the temporarily suspended its criminal jury trials and jury service until January 4, 2021. Any “in progress” trials will remain in session. For prospective jurors, please continue to check the court’s website for additional updates at <https://www.saccourt.ca.gov/jury/jury.aspx>.

The court is deemed an “essential service” and will in all other areas of court operations remain open to the public and serve the public through remote means. The court is committed to reducing the number of people in our facilities to protect the public, judicial officers and employees.

Again, the pause in criminal jury service is temporary and in direct response to the current health environment.
