Sacramento Superior Court Launches New Case Management System

Sacramento, CA – Sacramento Superior Court has launched the first phase of a new, electronic case management system.

All Civil and Probate case records are now accessible via a new public portal, a product of Journal Technologies Inc. The next phase will include Small Claims and Unlawful Detainer cases.

Information about changes in court processes related to the new public portal, such as subscriptions to cases, are posted on the Sacramento Superior Court website.

The transition to the new public portal involved months of mapping and integrating data from Sacramento Superior Court's current case management system to the new one. During this time of transition, court staff is available to assist the public with navigating the new system.

Over time, implementation of the public portal will be expanded and access to other case types will follow. Once fully implemented, parties and the public will be able to view and download non-confidential filings using the internet.

In conjunction with roll out of the new public portal, Sacramento Superior Court phased out all fees associated with online searches and document downloads. These fees had been in effect since July 2014, shortly after the court's current public case access website went online.

"Launching a new case management system is a tremendous undertaking, but this system will enable Sacramento Superior Court to administer justice more efficiently and better serve the community as a result," Presiding Judge Michael G. Bowman said.
