

ORDER

**UNLAWFUL DETAINER
PROCEEDINGS ON OUTSTANDING WRITS OF POSSESSION**

The Court amends its Temporary Court Closure Order issued March 19, 2020, to authorize the resumption of specified additional proceedings in unlawful detainer.

When the Court issued its Temporary Court Closure Order on March 19, 2020, post-judgment writs of possession had already been issued and served in fifty-five (55) specific unlawful detainer actions. The Court has determined that further processing and execution of those writs is not impaired by the Governor's executive order on eviction, the resolutions of the City or County of Sacramento, or the Judicial Council Emergency Rules of Court. The Court has also determined that it is currently able to process any documentation or proceedings related to this specific group of action within the restrictions of the health order restrictions.

Therefore, the Court is authorized to process documents, motions and the execution of all writs of possession that were issued by the Court as of March 18th, 2020. Any filings made through the drop box at the Carol Miller Justice Center regarding these cases will be accepted and processed by Court Staff as required by law. The court filing holiday and suspension that prevented action on this limited class of cases has now ended.
