**ORDER: REASSIGNMENT OF FELONY  
HOME COURT MATTERS IN THE EVENT  
OF DISQUALIFICATION.**

**IT IS THE ORDER OF THIS COURT** that in any action assigned to either Department 61, 62, or 63, and the regularly assigned Felony Home Court Judge is thereafter disqualified from the action for any reason, the action shall be assigned to another available Felony Home Court Judge for subsequent proceedings as follows:


- Department 61 shall assign cases ending in an even number to Department 62
- Department 61 shall assign cases ending in an odd number to Department 63
- Department 62 shall assign cases ending in an even number to Department 61
- Department 62 shall assign cases ending in an odd number to Department 63
- Department 63 shall assign cases ending in an even number to Department 61
- Department 63 shall assign cases ending in an odd number to Department 62

In the event that all regularly assigned Felony Home Court Judges have been disqualified from a case, the case shall be referred to Department 47 for reassignment purposes.
