**ORDER RE: CASH PAYMENTS**


**IT IS THE ORDER OF THIS COURT,** that cash payments made to the Court shall be rounded to the nearest five-cent increment, following general accounting principles for symmetrical rounding, as follows:

- If the final digit of the amount is 1 or 2, it shall be rounded down so that the amount ends in 0.
- If the final digit of the amount is 3 or 4, it shall be rounded up so that the amount ends in 5.
- If the final digit of the amount is 6 or 7, it shall be rounded down so that the amount ends in 5.
- If the final digit of the amount is 8 or 9, it shall be rounded up so that the amount ends in 0.

This Order shall apply only to cash transactions. Payments made by check, credit card, or electronic funds transfer shall be processed for the exact amount required by law or under the operative fee schedule.

1 This order shall supersede all previous orders by the Court regarding these matters and shall  
2 remain in effect until such time as it may be modified or revoked.
